

**WORTHINGTON CITY COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING, JUNE 9, 2008**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. in City Hall Council Chambers by Mayor Alan E. Oberloh with the following Aldermen present: Ron Wood, Mike Kuhle. Aldermen absent (excused): Lyle Ten Haken, Mike Woll, Bob Petrich.

Staff present: Gary Hoffmann, Interim Administrator; Dwayne Haffield, Director of Engineering; Janice Oberloh, City Clerk.

Others present: Darrell Stitt, KWOA.

As there was no quorum present for Council action, Mayor Oberloh noted the purpose of the meeting was to conduct a public meeting for review of the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan.

STORM WATER POLLUTION PREVENTION PLAN REVIEW

Dwayne Haffield, Director of Engineering, noted the purpose of the review was to give the public an opportunity to comment on the City's Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan. Mr. Haffield presented a slide show recapping the National Pollution Discharge Elimination System program (NPDES), and then briefly, our MS4 program. This review is part of the necessary process prior to submitting an annual report by the end of June.

The NPDES program is authorized under the Clean Water Act, and uses a five-year permit. There are three different categories within the Storm Water Discharge permitting program: Industrial, which covers the airport and treatment plant site; Construction, for all new construction projects that disturb over an acre; and the MS4 (Municipal Separated Storm Sewer System). Mr. Haffield talked about the technical resources and fact sheets available through the City's website, adding the sheets were sent out with utility billings. He also provided an explanation of the City's Storm Water Ordinance adopted in August of 2007.
