PRESENTATION BY TERRY GAALSWYK, MN WEST COMMUNITY/TECHNICAL COLLEGE

Terry Gaalswyk, President-MN West Community and Technical College, provide information to Council regarding programs offered through the college, Board Members, graduate numbers, etc., and noted that MN West was voted the No. 1 Community College in the State last year, and No. 3 On-Line Community College in the nation. Mr. Gaalswyck spoke of enrollment numbers, indicating they were up. He also reported they had completed their strategic planning process. Student housing remains a problem, and child care is an issue being addressed on their Granite Falls campus, but they hear the same concern with their employees here in Worthington too and hope to be able to address the issue.
