AWARD BID FOR WORTHINGTON AQUATIC CENTER PROJECT

Mr. Robinson said bids were received for the expansion of the City's outdoor Aquatic Center project on May 26, 2021. Three bids were received and Tri-State General Contracting of Jackson, MN was the low bidder with a bid of \$6,258,838.00. The estimate for the project is \$6.5 million dollars. Tri-State is planning to start the project on June 14th.

Mr. Robinson explained the improvements will add 9,875 square feet of new pool area and include a zero-depth splash area, recreation pool, slides and a lazy river. A separate bathhouse, driveway and parking area will complete the project. Todd Wietzema, Public Works Director, said that the sub-committee met several times and made some design changes and now staff is waiting on State approval. The estimated completion date is July 1, 2022.
