1. Annual Appointments - Designate Official Newspaper & Alternative Dissemination of Bid Solicitations, Requests for Proposals and Requests for Information

Designate Official Newspaper - Section 4.07 of the Worthington City Charter states that the City Council shall at its first regular meeting each year designate an official local newspaper (currently The Globe) for the publication of all matters required by law to be published.

Minn. Stat. 331A.12 states at the meeting of the governing body of a political subdivision at which the governing body designates its official newspaper for the year, the governing body may designate in the same manner publication of transportation projects on the political subdivision's Web site. Publication on the Web site may be used in place of or in addition to any other required form of publication. Each year after designating publication on the Website for bid solicitations, requests for proposal, and requests for information, the political subdivision must publish, in a qualified newspaper in the jurisdiction and on the Web site, notice that the political subdivision will publish advertisements for bids on its Website.

Exhibit 2 is the proposed 2024 agreement with The Globe for publication services.

Council action is requested to designate The Globe as the official newspaper for all matters required by law to be published in 2024 and authorize the website to be used as an alternative dissemination of bid solicitations, requests for proposals and requests for information.
